We will be looking at Christian themes, Jesus and his disciples and Easter

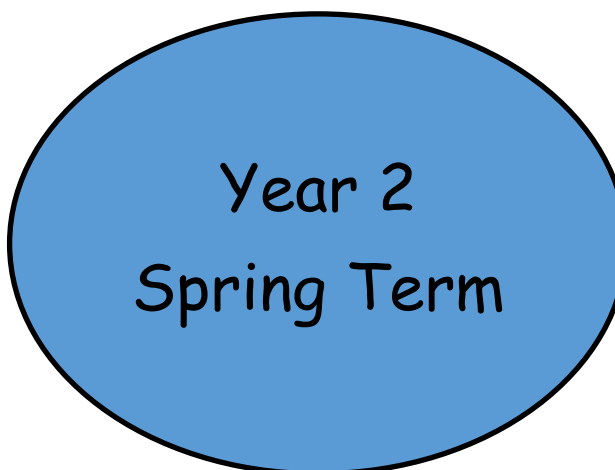
RRSA Article 14: The right to choose your own religion and beliefs.
