We will be working with a specialist music teacher thinking about musical composition, playing a variety of instruments as well as enjoying singing together.

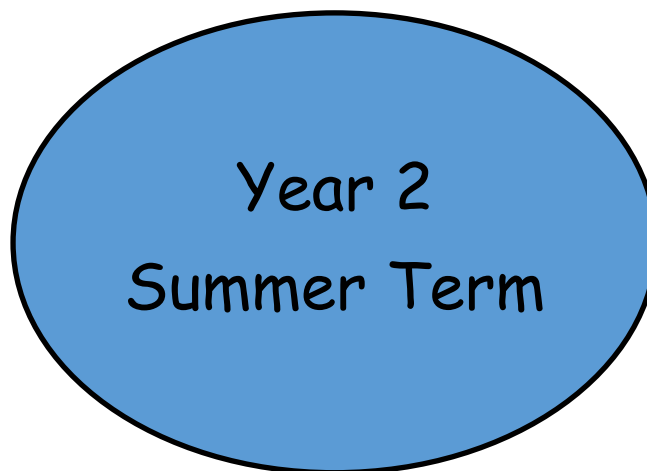
RRSA Article 29: Your education should help you use and develop your talents and abilities.
