

English

In English we will be studying playscripts, chronological reports, persuasive writing and recounts. We will also study odes and insults poetry. The spelling, punctuation and grammar curriculum will follow the LKS2 expectations.

Science

During science the children will learn about what electricity is and how it was discovered. Children will then construct circuits, start to create pictorial circuits and conduct an investigation into how easily different types of switches can break and reconnect a circuit.
