<p>Be respectful to teachers and teaching assistants.</p> <p>Try your hardest, even if you find something difficult.</p> <p>Take care of school property.</p> <p>Keep on task so that you don't distract anybody.</p>	<p>Make sure children understand their work.</p> <p>Help children if they are stuck.</p> <p>Plan fun and interesting lessons.</p> <p>Plan a range of lessons.</p> <p>Include all children in the lessons or activities.</p>	<p>Help children with their homework.</p> <p>If children are struggling with something at school, help them practise at home.</p> <p>Make sure children are reading daily.</p> <p>Bring children to school on time.</p> <p>Come to parents' evening.</p>

Article 29: You have the right to develop your talents and abilities.

<p>Try, try and try again. Don't be afraid to try new things. Always try their best. Be calm and respectful to PE coaches and other adults who come into school.</p>	<p>Provide lots of different lessons. Help children find something that they are interested in. Let children be creative. Be enthusiastic about new things. Encourage children to try new things.</p>	<p>Allow children to attend clubs. Let children go on trips. Encourage children to try new things. Let children choose what they want to join. Come into school to enjoy things with children.</p>

Article 19: You have the right to be protected from being hurt.

Say kind words to other people. Keep safe online. Make safe choices. Know who to ask for help. Be confident to tell an adult or another child something that you are worried about.	Be fair. Set rules for children to follow. Teach children how to be safe online. Make sure the school is safe. Make sure the gates are locked.	Know who to ask for help. Talk to children about their day. Set rules for children to follow.

Article 24: You have the right to nutritious food, fresh water and a clean and safe environment.

<p>Be polite towards dinner staff.</p> <p>Keep the classroom tidy.</p> <p>Check the cloakroom if you are a monitor.</p> <p>Try new foods at dinner time.</p> <p>Make healthy choices.</p> <p>Look after their own, other people and school property.</p>	<p>Teach children about making healthy choices.</p> <p>Let children drink water in the classroom.</p> <p>Make sure children have a healthy snack at playtime.</p> <p>Encourage children to try new food at lunchtime.</p> <p>Keep the classroom tidy.</p>	<p>Give children healthy choices and fresh water to drink.</p> <p>Make sure children have their uniform and PE kit.</p> <p>Take children to safe places to play like the park.</p>
