

Autumn Term 2018 - Year 1 Curriculum News

Dear Parents/Carers

We thought that you may be interested to learn about some of the varied and interesting work planned for the Autumn term in Year 1.

English - The main strands of fiction study this term are traditional tales, nursery rhymes and poems on a theme. Non fiction areas will include information texts and labels, lists and signs. We also have a daily 'Letters and Sounds' session.

Maths - The main areas of study are counting, reading and writing numbers in numerals and in words, addition and subtraction within 20. We also cover properties of 2D and 3D shapes throughout the term.

Science - The areas studied this term will include Animals including Humans and Seasons.

Computing - Y1 Children will be completing the units 'What is a Computer?' and 'Modern Tales' which focuses on online safety.

Cross Curricular Themed Topic- The theme for the term is Titanic. We will be looking at some of the history of the Titanic and the route it took. We will also design and produce our own boat.

Music - The children will gain knowledge in musical composition, playing a variety of instruments as well as enjoying singing together.

RE - We will be looking at Belonging in Christianity and Christmas.

PE - This term the children will be developing their dance and gymnastic skills. PE will be on a TUESDAY, but please ensure your child has a PE kit in school ALL week.

PSHE - Will be taught through a variety of games, circle times and discussions. We will be working on our New Beginnings topic, Friendship Week and E-Safety.
