Raising Concerns

If you have any worries or concerns regarding your child(ren), please see the class teacher in the first instance. If you want to speak to your child's class teacher at home time please wait until they have safely dismissed all of their children before approaching. It is important that they are able to concentrate on ensuring the children are collected by the correct people.

Lost property

It is vital that items of clothing brought into school are named. As the term progresses, we do find that we have an increasing number of unnamed items which cannot be returned to their owners.

Colder weather

As the weather becomes colder, it is vital that children bring coats to school and indoor shoes.

Water bottle reminder

All children should have a water bottle in school. Research has shown that children need to have regular amounts of water to aid concentration. Juice is not allowed.

Physical Education (PE)

P.E is part of the childrens' entitlement.

It is essential that children bring their PE kit each day and a change of footwear.

Children can wear the recommended plimsolls or may wear trainers as long as they are non -marking. However, they must not be the same footwear the child has been wearing all day.

Adventure trails Reminder

For Health and Safety reasons and insurance purposes CHILDREN ARE STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED on the adventure trails in Key Stage 1 or Key Stage 2 before and after school.

Packed Lunches

The school provides seating areas and supervision for children to sit and eat their packed lunch. All rubbish from packed lunches needs to be brought home so that parents/carers are aware of what has been eaten.

Dogs in the Playground




Some parents have commented that dogs have been brought into the school premises.


DRIVING & PARKING AROUND SCHOOL
