Mild 	Find out about a book that is special to someone in your family. Draw a picture of it and write about what the special book is, who it is special to and why it is special to them.	Can you count in 10s to 100? Try to write down the multiples of 10 in order.	Find out 3 facts about the Titanic. Write them in your own words.	Do you, or someone you know, have a pet? What animal is it and what do you, or someone you know, have to do to look after it? You can write or draw a picture to show your ideas.	Draw a person that might travel on the Titanic. Think about what clothes they might wear.
Hot 	Write a retell from a traditional fairy tale that you are familiar with. E.g. Little Red Riding Hood.	Adding and subtracting three. Start with any number between 1 and 100. Record at least 4 addition and 4 subtraction number sentences into your homework book. e.g. $42 + 3 = 45$ $75 - 3 = 72$	Can you find the route the Titanic would have taken on her Maiden Voyage? Can you list the cities she visited/would have visited?	What does Autumn mean for animals in this country? Write or draw pictures to show what happens to insects or woodland creatures during the Autumn.	What does Autumn look like in your garden, or in a park near you? Do you have a tree or plants that change during the year? Write a sentence and draw/paint a picture to show this.
Spicy 	Imagine you have shrunk and are trapped inside your house. Write a detailed description of what you would do.	Can you write down the times of your daily routine using the analogue time, <u>not</u> digital? Pick a day and write down what time you do different things e.g. 7 o'clock I get up. Half past 7 I eat my breakfast.	Can you write a timeline of some of the events leading up to the sinking of the Titanic? Start from the Titanic setting sail.	Can you keep a food diary for a weekend? Write/draw pictures to show what different types of food you are eating?	DT: Build a model of the Titanic. You can build it using Lego or recycled boxes and bottles. You can bring the model in or take a photo and stick it in your homework book.
