Y1 – local area unit links to George Stephenson History unit exploring local railways.

Teach both Geography units before teaching History to set the scene.

Teaching first Geography unit so that children get an awareness of where they are before exploring the wider location.

Y2 – What do we need to know about the UK? Unit to be taught before Bonfire and Remembrance.

What are the 7 continents and 5 oceans of the world? Unit to be taught before Captain James Cook.

Comparison work to be completed last.

Y3 - The United Kingdom – Landscape Unit to be taught before Stone Age Unit.

Changes to the land use in the United Kingdom. Unit to be taught after Stone Age Unit.

Study different types of coastlines around Britain and the coastal process. Teach unit after Rocks unit of work in Science.

Y4 – Is Europe the same all over? Unit to be taught before Roman unit.

How is the North East similar or different to Naples Bay Region in Italy? Unit to be taught after The Romans.

The Water Cycle and rivers. Taught alongside science unit states of matter.

Both The Water Cycle and rivers and States of Matter before the Egyptians – The River Nile

Y5 - What are some of the countries and cities of the UK and where are they located? Teach unit before Anglo Saxons and Vikings.

Is there more to North America than just Disneyland? Teach in Summer term.

Y6 – Links to Y5 Geog unit. Check with Charlotte M about Darwin links with Science?
