#### Breakfast Club – Proposed changes from September

The following message was issued to parents earlier this week in connection with Breakfast Club from September.

Dear Parents,

From September 2026, we are looking into changing our breakfast club provision, in line with the government's aims to provide universal free breakfast clubs for 30 minutes each day. We are aware that many families need the breakfast club for more than the 30 minutes, however, so we will continue to offer a paid provision from 7:45am. Unfortunately, this will mean we are unable to offer free bagels to all children on a morning, as this funding has been withdrawn, or the 10minutes soft start each morning, so gates will open at 8:50 for the start of the school day. In order to meet the government criteria, we are proposing to offer the following:

- 7:45-8:20 – Breakfast club available at a cost of £3.00 per child;
- 8:20-8:50 - Breakfast club free to all children from Reception to Year 6;
- 8:50 – Gates open for the start of the school day for all children.

Children will need to book into breakfast club 48 hours before, to ensure we have sufficient staffing and food in place.
